- 3. Children must be within arms length of a parent/guardian at all times for their own protection.
- 4. Running, horseplay and loud noises of any kind is prohibited. Disruption disturbs the patients as well as fellow guests.
- 5. Please refrain from placing hands, feet, underwater cameras or any other items in the tanks or pool. Turtles will bite and eat anything they find in the water.
- 6. Please do NOT touch the turtles.
- 7. Watch your step as you walk through the enclosure. There may be wet/slippery areas or uneven pavement.
- 8. Smoking, eating and/or drinking is prohibited in the turtle enclosure.
- 9. After your visit please wash your hands. Sea turtles are reptiles and the possibility of disease transfer does exist.
